

USA Maximum Cargo Weight

(estimated cargo weight based on standard maximum legal limit of 80,000 lbs total gross vehicle weight)

The following are guidelines for the maximum cargo weight in the U.S.

The recommended guidelines assume cargo weight is evenly distributed throughout the container.

U.S. HIGHWAY MAXIMUM CARGO WEIGHT

20-foot dry container (2-axle chassis): (16.8 MT)	37,000 lbs
20-foot refrigerated container (2-axle chassis): lbs (15.0MT)	33,069
40-foot dry container (2-axle chassis): (20.0 MT)	44,000 lbs
40-foot refrigerated container (2-axle chassis): lbs (18.2 MT)	40,013
45-foot refrigerated container (2-axle chassis): lbs (19.0 MT)	42,000
